to be a part of the team who is making plans to hold this year's 9th Annual Daffodil Tea.

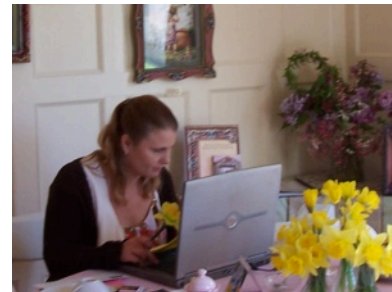
